Uniform requirements:

Footwear	Footwear must be enclosed at the front and back.
Top	School Polo shirt with sleeves and a collar. In winter, a school jumper or jacket or any clothing underneath the school polo top.
Bottom	Plain navy blue.
Headgear	Hats, caps, beanies or scarves covering the head are not to be worn inside and must be removed. Items that cover the face are not to worn at any time on school grounds.
Specialist Classes	Classes such as T&E and Science require, at times, the wearing of safety glasses and aprons/lab coats. Refusal to abide by the safety requirements of these classes will result in exclusion of student participation and parent contact.

Black clothing, 'street' wear, surf tops or clothing with large logos (larger than a thumb print) is NOT acceptable.

Any student not conforming to the dress code of the school shirt will be asked to wear a 'loan' shirt for the duration of the school day. Continual refusal to wear school uniform will involve parent contact and further consequences for the student.
